**Dyffryn Tips**

- Stock excluded in winter/spring 2022/2023. Vegetation to be monitored to inform next steps, which could include additional heath seeding.
- Grazing reintroduced when suitable dependent upon monitoring results.

**Allotments and Piece by Baker's**

- Bracken and gorse control - Gorse reduce to 50% of current extent, bracken to 10%.
- Some scattered tree planting in patches where gorse/scrub/bracken (fern) exists, protected by wooden tree guards (odd scattered trees, no dense planting).
- Hibernacula up to 5m in length created across area on a east to west orientation.
- Stock excluded during Nightjar nesting period April-Aug. Late summer and winter grazing, no limit.

**Mountain Grazing**


- Addition of shelterbelts that will provide both stock shelter and additional patches of scrub and higher height grassland/heathland vegetation suitable for wildlife such as nesting birds.

**Pond**

- Increase open water area by expanding size of pond. Ensure profiles are wildlife friendly by providing shallow sloping sides and grading into the neighbouring rush areas.

**Lambourne's Breast and Additional Area**

- Stock excluded during Nightjar nesting period April-Aug.
- Hibernacula up to 5m in length created across area on a east to west orientation.
- Bracken and gorse control - Gorse reduce to 50% of current extent, bracken to 10%.
