Site update

Following an extensive period of works over several years, we have already invested £20m into on and off site activity. Now, our on-site preparation works for 2023 have concluded and will recommence in Spring 2024. Thereafter, there will be continuous on-site activity from that point, through to resort opening, which is on track for 2027.

The Wildfox Resorts management team is actively refining the overall programme of work to ensure that the project is delivered successfully. The rephasing of some of the on-site activity will ensure the resort is delivered effectively, while we maximise the benefits to the community.

We have established new priorities on brand development, heritage, workforce development, social value and ongoing site safety. Our Director of Sustainability and Economic Development, Claire Pearce reiterates:

“Our mission is to turn this complex project into reality and make things happen. The Wildfox team have received a warm welcome from the community and a brilliant response from contractors, the college, local schools and local people who would like to work on the site during construction and when it is open, and we look forward to making progress with the next phase of the project”.

In order to maintain the site and protect residents, visitors and staff from Health and Safety matters, the temporary Public Right of Way closures will continue, in alignment with Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, under Section 14(1).

Our re-application for temporary closures will be in place from the beginning of August and be enforced for a further 6-month period. The notice and map can be found here -

Yn dilyn cyfnod helaeth o waith dros sawl blwyddyn, rydyn ni wedi buddsoddi £20m ar waith ar y safle ac oddi arno. Nawr, mae ein gwaith paratoi ar y safle ar gyfer 2023 wedi dod i ben, a bydd yn aildechrau yn y gwanwyn 2024. Bydd gweithgarwch parhaus ar y safle o'r pwynt hwnnw ymlaen, hyd nes y bydd y gyrchfan yn agor, sy'n debygol iawn o fod yn 2027.

Mae tîm rheoli Cyrchfannau Wildfox wrthi'n mireinio'r rhaglen waith gyffredinol ar hyn o bryd i sicrhau y bydd y prosiect yn cael ei gyflawni'n llwyddiannus. Bydd ailamseru rhyw gymaint o'r gwaith ar y safle'n sicrhau y gellir cyflenwi'r gyrchfan yn effeithiol, wrth i ni wneud yn fawr o'r manteision i'r gymuned.

Rydyn ni wedi sefydlu blaenoriaethau newydd o ran datblygu brand, treftadaeth, datblygu gweithlu, gwerth cymdeithasol a diogelwch ar y safle i'r dyfodol. Dyma ein Cyfarwyddwr Cynaliadwyedd a Datblygu Economaidd, Claire Pearce i ategu hyn:

Er mwyn cynnal y safle a gwarchod preswylwyr, ymwelwyr a staff rhag materion lechyd a Diogelwch, bydd y mesurau dros dro i gau Ffyrdd Tramwy Cyhoeddus yn parhau, yn unol â Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, Adran 14(1) a weithredir gan Gyngor Castell-nedd Port Talbot.

Heritage : We'll be working closely with archaeological experts and specialists with insights into the local area to build a deep understanding into the history of the Afan Valley. We'll be reviewing findings and exploring how to reflect and embed this into resort design through naming conventions, resort design and information boards.

The team will be inviting the local community to work with us to capture and celebrate the local industrial history of the valley in the Autumn and planning for that is now underway.
